<p>_____ Request teacher recommendations</p> <p><i>Give teachers a copy of your resume for their use in writing recommendations. Allow at least 2 weeks for return.</i></p>	Early to mid May
<p>_____ Scholarships:</p> <p>Register with Fastweb.com</p> <p>Plan ahead: Visit Bradford's website to see which you will be eligible for next year.</p>	
<p>_____ Personal statement /essays</p>	Summer
<p>_____ Meet with your counselor to review credits and discuss application and scholarship process</p>	Early September of Senior Year
