

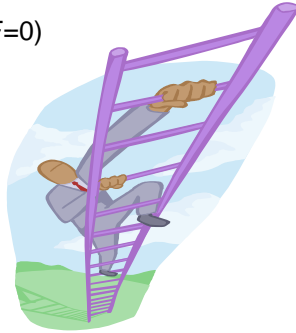
How do I rank?
