

Honors Convocation - Scholarship Form

What: Honors Convocation is a ceremony in which seniors are recognized for various awards, scholarships, and achievements they have earned

Where/When: The 2008 Honors Convocation will be held on May 23, 2008 at 8:00 a.m. in Bradford High Schools Auditorium. The ceremony is approximately one hour long. Parents/Guardians are welcome to attend. No tickets or calling ahead of time is necessary - just join us in the field house no earlier than 7:45 a.m.

How: Students who wish to be recognized in the ceremony are responsible for submitting a *copy* of the award/scholarship notification letter along with an Honors Convocation - Scholarship Form to the Freshman Academy Office no earlier than April 7 and no later than **April 25, 2008**. *Students can obtain the scholarship forms from the website, the Office of Life and Learning or their counselor.*

- **SCHOLARSHIP FORMS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED BEFORE THE STARTING DATE OR AFTER THE DEADLINE.**
- Because grants are typically based solely on financial need, they will not be recognized in the ceremony. Only merit-based scholarships will be recognized.

Reminders!

You can only report the scholarship(s) from the college/university you PLAN on attending for the 08-09 school year.

List the TOTAL amount. Many scholarship offered by universities are renewable for four years. Check the fine print and be sure to list the total for four years when this applies. IF you list the amount just for one year, that is what will be announced during the Honors Convocation.

Be sure to have a copy of the congratulatory letter attached to the Honors Convocation form that you turn in. The amount must be specified. This may require you to contact the admission office and ask them to put it in writing or send a fax to Bradford High School ATTN Robin Mars.

Be sure to put the entire scholarship/award title. For example, if you are receiving a scholarship from a particular college you need to put down the name of the college as well as the name of the scholarship (UW-Platteville/Athletic Award - \$4,000)
